# **COMMUNITY CLEAN-UP**

The Borough of West View will be holding a Community Clean-Up Day on October 21st. This event will offer 3 dumpsters for items that normal trash collection requires you to schedule. Items that will NOT be collected are anything electrical (televisions, radios, computers and monitors, disc players, etc.), paint that is not dried out, and tires of any kind. Dumpsters will be located at the Borough tax office parking lot. They will be available from 9am to 1pm. Volunteers for the clean-up will meet at 9am at the West View VFW Post 2754, 386 Perry Highway.

# MILITARY BANNER PROGRAM

Our Military Banner Program is still going strong. We will be removing the banners after Veterans Day to clean and store them during the winter months. # **DUMPSTER PERMITS**

If you are using a dumpster in a residential area within the Borough of West View, you are required to obtain a dumpster permit through our office. Applications can be picked up at the Borough office Monday through Friday, 8am to 4pm. They are also available on our website at www.wvboro.com.

# MUNICIPAL ELECTION

This year's Municipal Election Day is Tuesday, November 7th, 2023. The polls are open from 7am to 8pm. If you are unsure of your polling location, you can check our website to find out. The last day to request a mail-in or absentee ballot is October 31st, 2023.

# STREET SWEEPING

Street sweeping will continue through November 14th, 2023. Just a reminder that any unpaid tickets will result in a state citation with additional fines and costs, so please pay any unpaid tickets you may have. Thank you for your cooperation in keeping our streets clean. This is a mandatory storm water management program that benefits us in many ways. Street Sweeping will resume in April 2024.

# PUBLIC WORKS NEWS

The Department of Public Works has completed 910 work orders so far this year. The Borough's annual street paving project was completed last month with the following streets being paved: Center Avenue from Oakwood to Brightwood, Jamaica Avenue, Norval Alley, Arden Alley, Bryant Alley, and 7th Alley. In addition, Phase 1a of the Streetscape Project has been completed.

# HALLOWEEN PARADE

West View's Annual Halloween Parade will take place on Monday, October 30th, 2023 at 7pm. The parade will form at 6:30pm on Highland Avenue at Perry Highway.

This year's parade sign-ups will once again be online ONLY. The online form is available on our website (wvboro.com) or by scanning the QR code below. You MUST have a valid email address in order to sign up. This form will automatically assign your child a unique registration number which will then be sent to the email address you entered into the form. Please allow up to 2-3 business days for the email to appear in your inbox. IF YOU ARE SIGNING UP MORE THAN ONE CHILD, YOU MUST FILL OUT THIS FORM MORE THAN ONCE. From there, you must print or write your child's number in permanent marker on a halfsheet of standard 8.5" x 11" paper. This number should be pinned to your child's right side. Your child's registration number must be readable so that your child can receive a goodie bag and be eligible for the costume prizes.

The prize winners will be posted on the Borough website on October 31st, 2023. Prizes may be picked up at the Borough building from 8am to 4pm, Monday through Friday, beginning on October 31st, 2023.

## **NH SENIOR PASS**

North Hills School District offers free athletic passes to residents age 60 or older entitling them to free admission to all North Hills athletic events. To obtain a senior citizens pass, visit the Athletics & Activities Office which is located on the first floor of North Hills High School, 53 Rochester Road, Pittsburgh, PA 15229. Proof of age and residency via a driver's license, passport, or a document with a photo ID is required. The senior citizens pass does NOT include admission to events such as the school play or spring musical. However, the district does offer senior citizen discounts and/or senior citizen performances. # PAY YOUR EMS FEE TODAY!

Earlier this year, Ross/West View EMSA implemented a **mandatory** annual EMS fee in each of the municipalities it serves. This fee is to provide a sustainable source of funding for the EMS. The fee is \$55 per household. Once you have paid this fee, you will not have to pay any out-of-pocket ambulance fees that are not covered by insurance. # **SNOW REMOVAL**

It is the responsibility of every property owner and tenant to clear sidewalks of snow and ice within 24 hours after a snow or ice event ends. Children and persons walking to bus stops, mail carriers, delivery persons, emergency responders, and your friends and neighbors need a safe place to walk. Snow cannot be deposited on any public street or sidewalk. Do not shovel snow into the roadway! A 3-foot minimum clear zone must be maintained around a fire hydrant. If you live on a corner, clear a space for people crossing the street to enter the sidewalk.

# WASTE MANAGEMENT CART DELIVERY

Attention all residents: We have been informed by Waste Management that the new trash and recycling carts will NOT be delivered until after the 1st of 2024 due to ongoing supply issues. Please continue to use your current trash cans and recycling bins until they are delivered. As a reminder, trash service will remain the same until the new carts are delivered. However, once the new carts arrive, all trash will have to fit inside the carts. Bulk items will only be collected every 3rd full week of the month once these new carts are delivered.

# LEAF COLLECTION

Leaf collection will begin on October 23rd and end on December 1st. The Department of Public Works (DPW) will follow the street sweeping schedule regarding days of collection. You may place brown paper leaf bags or loose leaves at the curb. To better serve residents, you can also go to our website and click the "Request Leaf Collection" link to request a pick-up. Please be courteous when placing leaves at the curb. Do not block catch basins, driveways, sidewalks, or fire hydrants. After December 2nd, yard waste will no longer be collected by the Public Works Department.

Additionally, on Saturday, October 21st and Saturday, November 18th, Waste Management will also collect yard waste. Simply place your yard waste in a biodegradable bag and put it at the curb and Waste Management will pick it up.

# PRESCRIPTION DRUG TAKE BACK BOX PROGRAM

The Borough of West View has a "Prescription Drug Take Back Box." The secure large red drop-off box is located inside the main lobby of the West View Borough building at 441 Perry Highway. Anyone can use the drop off box during normal Borough business hours (Monday through Friday 8:00am to 4:00pm). This service is for anyone wanting to dispose of unwanted or unneeded prescription drugs, non-prescription drugs, and vitamins. NO LIQUID OR NEEDLES ARE TO BE PLACED IN THE BOX – THIS IS DUE TO OBVIOUS SAFETY CONCERNS FOR THE PEOPLE WHO EMPTY THE BOX. This is a safe alternative to disposing of them yourself or keeping them in your house.
