

### Dear West View Borough Resident:

WM is proud to be your environmental solutions provider. As part of our new contract with West View Borough, all residents will receive automated curbside collection. Our automated collection service will provide residents with a new 96-gallon cart for trash and a 64-gallon cart for recycling. Yard waste will be collected once a month from April - November. The calendar attached includes your schedule.

WM is excited to continue our partnership with West View Borough and looks forward to helping your community be as clean and green as possible.

### General Information

Your collection day will remain the same. All items must be placed at the curb no later than 6:00 a.m. on the day of your collection. Despite our best efforts, we occasionally miss scheduled collections. If we do, please call us at (800) 451-3060 as soon as you can. Our representatives will work with you to ensure your materials get picked up. You can also visit [www.wm.com](http://www.wm.com) for live chat and email options.

### Trash Collection

- In early 2023, each household will be provided with a wheeled 96-gallon Black cart with a Black lid for trash. And a wheeled 64-gallon Black cart with a Blue lid for recycling.
- Carts will be delivered this spring, and more information about cart delivery will be available soon.
- Please continue using your current can(s) until you receive your new cart.
- Make sure your material is at the curb the night before your scheduled collection or by 6:00 a.m. the day of your pickup.
- Once carts are delivered, all trash must fit inside your selected cart with the lid firmly closed.
- No additional trash will be picked up outside the cart.
- Bulk items will be collected once a month during the 3rd full week of the month. Please reference the calendar for your 2023 bulk collection dates.
- Make sure there are at least 3 feet between your carts and any obstacles – mailboxes, parked cars or trees.

### Recycle Collection

- Recyclables will be collected every week. All items must fit in your provided 64-gallon recycling cart.
- Please see the reverse side of this brochure for items that are accepted in your recycling program.

### Yard Waste Collection

- Yard waste is collected once a month on the 3rd Saturday from April through November. Please see the calendar to find your 2023 yard waste collection Days.
- Yard waste includes, leaves, clippings, and small branches. And must be placed in **BIODEGRADABLE TRASH BAGS ONLY** for collection.

### Bulk Items and Overflow Material

**WM will only collect material that fits inside your trash and recycling cart.** All trash must be bagged and fit inside the provided cart. Recyclables must be placed loose into your recycling cart and boxes must be broken down.

Residents may purchase up to two (2) additional 96-gallon trash carts for an additions \$8 per cart per month. Residents may also purchase up to two (2) additional 64-gallon recycling carts for \$7 per cart per month.

If you prefer, 35-gallon carts are also available for \$6 per cart per month.

- West View Borough Residents 65 and over are eligible for a Senior Discount of 15%. Call: **1-800-866-4460** to Register.

WM will collect one bulk item once per month during the 3rd full week of the month at no additional charge. Place your bulk item at the curb on the same day as your trash collection during your bulk collection week. Residents are permitted one bulk item per month at no additional charge. Additional items can be arranged for pickup for a fee by calling WM.

### What is a bulk item?

A bulk item is an appliance, piece of furniture, or some other residential item that is too large for a container. Construction debris and hazardous waste are not permitted as bulk items. WM asks that residents call (800) 451-3060 in advance to schedule collection of a white-goods appliance.

### Bulk Waste

- Furniture including chairs, tables, armoires, cabinet, chest, headboard, sofa, mattresses, dressers and interior doors
- Household appliances including washer, dryer, dishwasher, stove, toilet, refrigerator (freon must be removed), microwave, hot water tank, etc.
- Carpeting (must be cut into 4-foot bundles)
- Picnic table or bench (unattached), basketball board or pool (6' or less in height), swing set (unassembled)

### NOT Bulk Waste and Unaccepted Materials

- Concrete, brick, asphalt, roofing, electronics
- Vehicles and parts
- Building materials such as plaster, dry wall, wood, construction debris, etc.

### At Your Door Special Collection Service

Residents will continue to have access to the At Your Door Special Collection Service to properly dispose and recycle household hazardous waste in a safe, easy and responsible manner. These items include paints, household cleaners, compact fluorescent lamps (CFL), automotive products, garden chemicals, batteries, televisions, computers, and more.
